To disconnect the USB cable (or remove the SD card), click "Safely Remove Hardware" icon and select "Safely remove USB Mass Storage Device – Drives(X:, X:)" as shown below.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Program stops responding when using it.

Tap reset button at the back of the navigator and re-launch the navigation software.

My search is returning too many results.

Try performing a search by entering the most unique part of the keyword, for eq. *IKANO for Ikano Power Centre*.

■ The location shown in the navigator does not reflect my true current location.

Check if the navigator is lock on to GPS satellite. You will need at least 3 satellites to be locked on. Fourth satellite is needed to identify your altitude.

Voice guidance is not audible when navigating.

Check the volume control of the navigator.

- The navigation software cannot be launched.
  - 1. Check the condition of the SD card. Change the SD card if it is damaged.
  - 2. Check the SD card for viruses. If the SD card is infected by virus, format it and copy the software from the CD provided.
